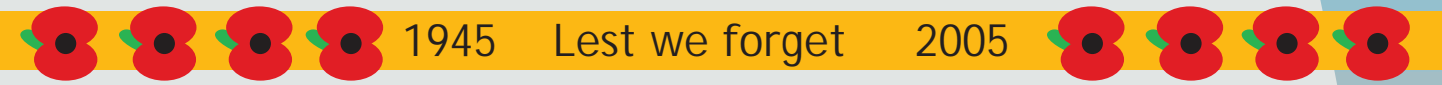

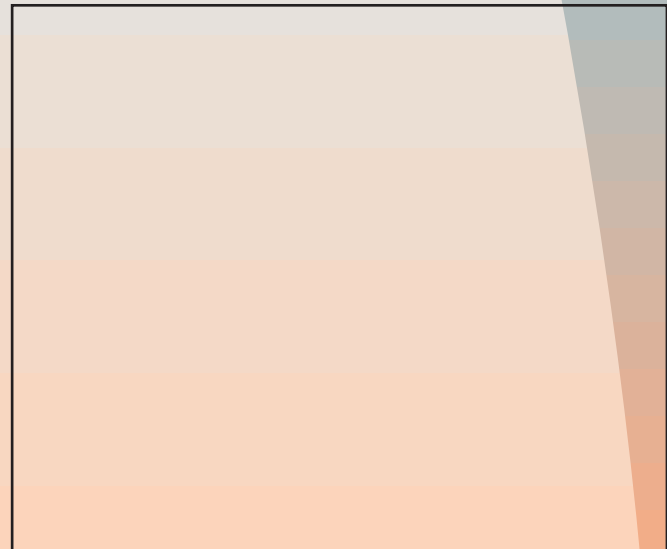

SKATEPARK - LATEST NEWS

The prospect of the Bridlington Skatepark, at Dukes Park, becoming reality, took a major step in July when the Council agreed to be the lead body and to oversee the building and running of it. The Council praised the work of Simone Wilkinson and all the members of the Skatepark Steering Group in the painstaking work of researching the project and convincing the various funding partners to support it.

Cyril Oliver, who had recently taken over as the group's Treasurer, presented an updated financial report to the Council which showed that the funding jigsaw was very nearly in place, pending an application via the Bridlington Regeneration Partnership to Yorkshire Forward for a top-up allocation of capital and additional funding to employ a project manager/development worker. The Council resolved to set up a management committee, made up of councillors, plus members of the local community who will form the majority of the committee's membership. The Clerk's report to Council concluded: "It is important that the Council is seen to be an enabling partner and not perceived to be in any way dominating or hi-jacking the project. A strong sense of community ownership is essential if the project is to have a successful outcome."

It is anticipated that the committee will be established in September and that work on the site can begin as soon as Yorkshire Forwards support is confirmed.
