Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 10th May 2017
in the Quay Centre, Quay Road (at the rear of Christ Church), Bridlington

Present: Councillors Copsey, B Croft, C Croft, Dealtry, Dixon, Finlay, Foster, Heslop-Mullens, Holmes, Marsburg, M Milns & T Milns (12). There were four (4) members of the public and two (2) other members of staff present. Mrs Paula King, Town Clerk took the minutes.

01.17 Mayor's Welcome & Election of the Mayor of Bridlington for the Council Year 2017-2018:

Councillor Dealtry welcomed everyone to the meeting and called for the election of Mayor of Bridlington to commence. Councillor Marsburg was proposed by Councillor Dealtry and was seconded by Councillor Foster.

RESOLVED: *Councillor Marsburg is elected Mayor for the Council Year 2017-18.*

02.17 Declaration of Acceptance by the Mayor of Bridlington:

Councillor Marsburg read out the declaration of office and duly signed it before the nominated Proper Officer of the Council. Councillor Marsburg thanked the Councillors for giving him the opportunity of becoming Mayor of Bridlington for the third time and declared it an honour. He pledged to carry out the duties to the best of his ability, with dignity and decorum as he has always done in the past. He paid tribute to the outgoing Mayor Councillor Liam Dealtry for his year in office, a successful one, which he carried out in his own unique way. The Mayor said that he was sorry that the Deputy Mayor was not able to take up the role of Mayor but that he understood why.

RESOLVED: *There were none as everyone was in attendance.*

04.17 Mayor's announcement of Consort and Charity for the Council Year 2017-18:

Councillor Marsburg announced that he would like to ask Councillor Foster to be his Mayoress for the Mayoral Year 2017-2018 and she accepted. The Mayor's chosen charity is to benefit Dementia and Alzheimer's in the East Riding of Yorkshire.

05.17 Outgoing Mayor's verbal report, civic duties, departing speech and presentations:

Cllr Dealtry read out his departing speech. He thanked all the Councillors for their support throughout his Mayoral Year. Councillor Dealtry mentioned a few points for the Councillors to consider for the forthcoming year which included office visiting, dress for meetings and finished off by sharing how sad he was that Councillor Malcolm Milns had decided not to take up office. Councillor Marsburg presented the outgoing Mayor a Past Mayor and Past Mayoress Clasp for on behalf of the Council. Councillor Dealtry presented the Council with a BBB Silver Spoon and an individual BBB pin badge to all Councillors and staff of the Bridlington Town Council. Councillor Dealtry previously presented his nominated charities with a total amount of £2667.40 (two thousand six-hundred and sixty seven pounds and forty pence) that he has managed to raise for them all over his Mayoral Year. The Royal British Legion Alderson House, Humberside & South Yorkshire Army Cadet Force Bridlington Detachment, Bridlington 252 Sqn Air Training Corps & the Sea Cadet Unit Bridlington were presented with their share of the total which was a cheque for £666.85 (six hundred and sixty six pounds and eighty five pence) each.
