Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 8th May 2019
in the Key Centre, Quay Road (at the rear of Christ Church), Bridlington

Present: Councillors Dealtry, Finlay, Foster, Holmes, Marsburg, T Milns, Norman & Walker (8). There were six (6) members of the public and the Civic Officer, Miss Abigail Grosse. Mrs Paula King, Town Clerk took the minutes.

01.19 Mayor's Welcome & Election of the Mayor of Bridlington for the Council Year 2019-2020:

Councillor Croft welcomed everyone to the meeting and read out the intention to record.
Councillor Croft then called for the election of Mayor of Bridlington to commence.
Councillor Dealtry was proposed by Councillor Marsburg and was seconded by Councillor T Milns.

RESOLVED: *Councillor Dealtry is elected Mayor for the Council Year 2019-20.*

02.19 Declaration of Acceptance by the Mayor of Bridlington:

Councillor read out the declaration of office and duly signed it before the nominated Proper Officer of the Council. Councillor thanked the Councillors for giving him the opportunity of becoming Mayor of Bridlington.

03.19 Apologies for absence:

04.19 Mayor's announcement of Mayoress and Charity for the Council Year 2019-2020:

Councillor Dealtry announced that Mrs Michelle Dealtry, his wife, would be his Mayoress for the Mayoral Year 2019-2020. The Mayor's chosen charities are the Royal British Legion Alderson House, 252 Squadron ATC, Bridlington Detachment Humberside & South Yorkshire Cadet Force, Bridlington Sea Cadets & Bridlington School CCF. All charity money raised will be shared equally with the five charities.

05.19 Outgoing Mayor's verbal report, civic duties, departing speech and presentations:

Councillor Croft declared that he had had a wonderful year in Office and that it was an absolute pleasure having both his wife Councillor Bridie Croft, Mayoress and Councillor Shelagh Finlay as his Consort at his side during the year. He thanked everyone for their support and shared how much he had enjoyed the many wonderful events and meeting such inspiring people along the way. He informed the meeting that he, his Mayoress and Consort undertook 109 civic duties throughout the year and that the Mayors Cadet had attended 14 of those civic duties with him. The Deputy Mayor and Mayoress undertook 74 civic duties during the year. Other Councillors and Staff undertook 115 duties during the year and overall the Council cumulatively undertook 312 duties between them.
