74.14 Apologies for absence:

RESOLVED: *Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr J Copsey, Cllr L Dealtry, Cllr J Foster and Cllr L Chambers.*

75.14 Declarations of Interest:

RESOLVED: *There was one declaration of non-pecuniary interest from Cllr T Milns in respect of item 13 on the agenda as Cllr T Milns is a member of two of the groups.*

85.14 The Details of the VAT Repayment:


RESOLVED: *The committee received and noted details of the VAT repayment.*
