**71.16 Apologies for absence:**

**RESOLVED:** *Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor T Milns.*

**72.16 Declarations of Interest:**

Otherwise, it is requested to the East Riding Of Yorkshire Council that the board be removed as per the original agreement, which was to facilitate provision for cleaning and minor repairs, not substantial repairs and alterations, relocation or full replacement.*
