**75.17 Apologies for absence:**

**RESOLVED:** *Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr T Dixon.*

**76.17 Declarations of Interest:**

**RESOLVED:** *The committee resolved to proceed with the quotation from N Power for the Council's gas and electricity supplies.*


