### SUMMARY OF PRECEPT BRIDLINGTON TOWN COUNCIL

### FINANCIAL YEAR 2017/2018

Each year Bridlington Town Council is obliged to produce a budget to cover its operational costs. The Town Council requests the East Riding of Yorkshire Council to levy a charge on every domestic property within the three Bridlington wards. This charge is known as the Precept and the cost to each household is dependent upon the Council Tax Band that the property falls into. The bands range from 'A' to 'H' and the Town Council's 2017/2018 Precept ranges from 26p per week for an 'A' band property to 79p per week for a 'H' band property. The Precept has seen a 12.3% increase this year due to the ongoing increased costs and also to safeguard support for community projects and events. Cadets from Bridlington 252 Squadron Air Training Corps will be seen over the next few weeks spraying the "Please clean up after your dog" stencils and placing dog fouling signs on Lamp posts and Bins. The cadets are working towards the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze award and doing this counts towards the Environmental aspect of the award, Warrant Officer Hill said he is pleased the cadets are doing this & to be working alongside the Town Council.

Advice regarding reporting issues - if the same person repeatedly lets their dog foul and you know who it is, you can report dog fouling using an online form for the Dog Wardens to investigate by contacting the Dog Wardens at the East Riding of Yorkshire Council via the website or telephoning 01482 393939. You can also ask the ERYC to clean a street or public place if dog fouling has become a problem on the same website page. For the removal of faeces in the Town you can contact ERYC on 01482 393939. The Town Council supply biodegradable doggie bags that can be purchased from the Town Council offices at 62 Quay Road costing £1.25 for 50 bags.

## SUCCESSFUL AWARD OF A BRIDLINGTON ASSETS OF COMMUNITY VALUE



The Town Council have recently worked with the Alexandra bowling Club to secure it as an Asset of Community Value. The award sees the club awarded this status for five years.

Do you consider that there are other buildings or assets within Bridlington that could be considered an asset of community value which is described as a building or a piece of land in either public or private ownership could be considered to have community value? The definition of which would be that the main use of the asset is currently, or in the recent past, has furthered the social wellbeing or the cultural, recreation or sporting needs of the local community.

The Town Council can apply for such buildings to be protected but require residents of Bridlington to get in touch with what areas of the Town are considered suitable nominations for the Town Council to act upon (which could potentially be provided as supporting evidence for application).
