### Section A:

#### 01/06 Election of a Chairman:

Councillor Harrap Nominated by Councillor Grange and Seconded by Councillor L Taylor

#### 05/06 The estimate from the Stone Gallery for the refurbishment of the Jubilee Fountain:

A figure of £1,189.54 plus vat has been estimated by the Stone Gallery to empty, scrub and refill the pool surround. Also to pressure clean the pipes and tubing, replace the pump, lighting and transformer.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. To accept the estimate of £1,189.54 plus vat;
2. To consult with the ERYC regarding the plans for the Spa Environs.

#### 06/06 Sewerby Cricket Club and the provision of public conveniences in Sewerby:

Sewerby Cricket Club is willing to make the use of their toilets available for public use annually between 1<sup>st</sup> May and 30<sup>th</sup> September. The club is currently progressing a scheme to build a new cricket pavilion for the 2007 season.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. A grant of £10,000 is offered to Sewerby Cricket Club towards the provision of a new pavilion by way of an agreement for the public use of the club's toilets between 1<sup>st</sup> May and 30<sup>th</sup> September annually;
2. A contract is entered into at a fee of £1,000 per annum indexed for inflation for a term of 21 years with periodic reviews at 7 and 14 years for the ongoing public use of the club's toilets between 1<sup>st</sup> May and 30<sup>th</sup> September.

#### 07/06 Honorary Freedom of Bridlington to The 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, The Yorkshire Regiment (Green Howards):

The Clerk presented a report outlining the costs of the ceremony and reception associated with the granting of the Honorary Freedom to The 2nd Battalion, The Yorkshire Regiment (Green Howards).
