89.12 Apologies for absence:

RESOLVED: *Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Chambers and Cllr Copsey.*

90.12 Declarations of Interest:

Mr Clayden Wished to speak regarding item 5- Salt bin for Cleeton Way. He advised the committee that he had been nominated to act as a representative for the residents of Cleeton Way. Mr Clayden advised that the residents are seeking two salt bins to be placed and maintained on Cleeton Way, Bridlington. He advised the committee that there had been a number of issues during periods of severe weather, there had been reports of ambulances and delivery drivers struggling to gain access and a number of falls by elderly residents. The chair advised that Mr Clayden's information would be taken into consideration when the item was discussed on the agenda.
