



BRIDLINGTON TOWN COUNCIL
Minutes of the Finance & General Purposes Committee
held on Tuesday 7th July 2015 in the
Town Councils Offices, 62 Quay Road, Bridlington

Present: Councillors J Copsey, T Dixon, S Finlay (Chair), G Holmes and T Milns, total of five (5) and two (2) members of the public.

Mrs Exon, Responsible Financial Officer, recorded the minutes.

18.15 Apologies for absence:

RESOLVED: *Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr J Foster and Cllr L Dealtry.*

19.15 Declarations of Interest:

a) *To record declarations of interest by any member of the council in report of the agenda items listed below. Members declaring interests should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared.*

RESOLVED: *There were no declarations of interest in respect of items on the agenda.*

b) *To note dispensations given to any member of the council in respect of the agenda items listed below:*

RESOLVED: *There were no dispensations given in respect of items on the agenda.*

20.15 Public Participation session to include items on the agenda (two minutes per person - maximum of fifteen minutes) to include members of the Public and Councillors with interests:

RESOLVED: *There was no public participation.*

21.15 The purchase of trees for the skatepark:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to investigate further the possibility of placement of trees and report back to the next Finance and General Purposes committee meeting with details of suitable species, sizes and costings.*

22.15 The resident request to replace an existing lighting column at Church Green with a Heritage Column:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved not to replace the existing lighting column.*

23.15 The Ongoing arrangements for Skate Club:

RESOLVED: *The committee noted details of the report provided and resolved to approve the proposals suggested and provide a cancellation fee of 50% of the hire fee in the incidence of a last minute cancellation due to bad weather, resulting in the session not being able to be undertaken.*

24.15 The Resident correspondence regarding the Seafront Flags Provision:

RESOLVED: *The committee considered the details of the resident's correspondence and the additional information provided. The committee resolved not to make any changes to the existing seafront flag provision.*

25.15 The renewal of the Skate Park Maintenance contract:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to renew the skate park maintenance contract for a further twelve (12) months. Total Value £5493.70.*

26.15 The Website Consultant contract:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to award a twelve (12) month contract to provide ten (10) hours service per month to the council. Total Value £1608.00.*

27.15 The litter bin requests by a resident via a Bridlington Free Press article 11th June 2015:

RESOLVED: *The committee considered the site visit report provided by the Responsible Financial Officer and resolved to proceed with placement of litter bins at South Back Lane snicket, entrance to Queensgate Park (Flamborough Rd), Palace Car Park (next to Gypsy Race footpath). Placement will be on the proviso that East Riding Of Yorkshire Council agree the proposed sitings and also that their litter teams are able to add them to their emptying rounds.*

28.15 The purchase of a litter bin for Church Lane, Sewerby:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to purchase a litter bin for Church Lane, Sewerby. Placement will be on the proviso that East Riding Of Yorkshire Council agree the proposed siting and also that their litter teams are able to add it to their emptying rounds.*

29.15 The proposal for placement of a bus shelter on Harewood Avenue and the associated public consultation feedback:

RESOLVED: *The committee noted details of the feedback. Letters were hand delivered to residents of Harewood Avenue and the adjoining side streets, there were forty three (43) responses, seven (7) of which were in favour of a bus shelter installation and thirty six (36) were against. The committee resolved therefore not to proceed with placement of a bus shelter on Harewood Avenue.*
