Minutes of the Environment Committee Held on Monday 7th April 2026

A meeting was held with Five (5) Councillors L Dealtry, M Heslop-Mullens, C Verda, Andy Walker and Angie Walker
The Responsible Financial Officer recorded the minutes of the meeting.
There were no members of the public present.

171.25/26 The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting (with Notification of Recording & Fire Disclaimer).

172.25/26 Apologies for Absence:

RESOLVED: *Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr C Marsburg – due to ill health.*

173.25/26 Declarations of Interest:

The committee had explored the feasibility of installing CCTV to the whole site but found this to be prohibitively expensive.*
